DRPT conducted a comparative review of pricing following a price increase with lowered floor ADA accessible body-on-chassis cutaways on State Contract #E194-94462 (CTR005734). This analysis reviews other state pricing of vehicles to determine reasonableness of the requested price increase by the dealer, Sonny Merryman.

Florida: Experienced awarded a contract for similar lowered floor ADA vehicles (Ford E-450) ARBOC Spirit of Freedom:

24' Bus: Chevy ARBOC Spirit of Freedom: \$146,627

27' Bus: Ford ARBOC Spirit of Freedom: \$153,145

Louisiana:

24' Bus: Arboc Spirit of Freedom 12 Passenger (Chevy): \$139,084 (as of 9.9.2022)

Gas/Diesel/CNG 12 Passenger (FORD): \$151,054

Summary:

We reviewed pricing from Michigan, Florida, and Louisiana. Michigan recently had a price increase with similar vehicles and was found to be approximately 9% higher than that of vehicle offered by Sonny Merryman on this solicitation. Florida had similar vehicles on state contract from the same manufacturer, ARBOC. These vehicles for Florida were approximately 3% higher than that offered to Virginia by Sonny Merryman. Louisiana had pricing for similar vehicles from September 2022 which showed a smaller bus (12 Passenger) with similar pricing that was offered to Virginia for a slightly larger vehicle (13 Passenger) with a difference of only \$3,573. Updated pricing, once available to Louisiana will likely show and increased price for these vehicles.

Based off our original independent cost estimate for these vehicles at the prior to the start of the contract, we expected a 17 Passenger ARBOC to cost approximately \$139,000. The base price for for a similar vehicle offered in this solicitation cost approximately \$140,000.

Therefore, in conclusion, DRPT finds the proposed price increase of these vehicles to be fair and reasonable based on a review conducted by DRPT staff reviewing peer states current pricing for similar base model vehicles.

We will continue to monitor other state contracts for this type of vehicle as new pricing is made publicly available. The price increases and vehicle order delays experienced for these vehicles are unprecedented. As a result, Virginia, along with other state DOT's, are conducting due diligence to adequately compare and analyze pricing prior to making decisions on acceptance of these increases.
